

PDT MACRON CONFIRMS THE CREATION OF THE MEMORIAL MUSEUM OF TERRORISM IN SURESNES

USPA NEWS - "On March 11, 2020, during the first national day of homage to the victims of terrorism, the President of the French Republic announced the creation of the Terrorism Memorial Museum following the first report of the prefiguration mission chaired by the historian Henry Rousso and the work carried out by Elisabeth Pelsez, former interministerial delegate for victim assistance. One year later, a decisive step towards the creation of a museum of history and society that is unique and unique in its design is taken: the Head of State has chosen a site in Suresnes, in the immediate vicinity of the Memorial of combatant France."

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This new museum, thus part of a memorial journey, will take place in the current premises of the National Higher Institute of Training and Research for the Education of Young People with Disabilities and Adapted Teaching (INSHEA) which is due to move soon to Saint -Germain-en-Laye.-----

The site ideally corresponds to the recommendations of the foreshadowing mission, which is delighted that the active research it has been carrying out over the past year has thus been successful. The symbolism of the site responds to the desire to create both a place of resilience and resistance.-----

"RESILIENCE IS IN FACT WRITTEN INTO THE ORIGIN OF THSI MODERNIST BUILDING BUILT FOR CHILDREN IN DIFFICULTY IN THE 1930's-----

Resilience is in fact written into the origin of this modernist building, built for children in difficulty in the 1930s. Resistance is inherent in its very location because the building is in Mont-Valérien, a center of our national memory. The site thus offers a place of educational awareness of recent history which is at the heart of the project. The State will continue to provide the prefiguration mission, in conjunction with the city of Suresnes in particular, with its support for the accomplishment of all the dimensions of this project, as long as the project enters the concrete phase of its realization, Alongside the associations of victims of terrorism and many stakeholders, the mobilization of everyone in favor of the recognition of the victims of these tragedies and the desire to pass on to future generations continue with the prospect of a first stone to be laid in March 2022. » Source: Elysee
