## **A WHITE MARCH TO PAY TRIBUTE TO STEPHANIE KILLED BY HER COMPANION IN HAYANGE**

### **43rd FEMINICIDE IN 2021 IN FRANCE**

**USPA NEWS** - A rally is taking place this Wednesday evening in Hayange (Moselle) in tribute to the 43rd, victim of the femicide of Stephanie, 22 years old, stabbed in the night from Sunday to Monday in the middle of the street by her spouse. The white march was organized on May 26 at 6:00 pm, where the emotion is palpable and strong. The majority of the media have covered this in vain because this femicide is the 43rd, since the beginning of the year 2021, and because there is a woman who dies every three minutes in France. Despite a great "Grenelle" debate on the fight against violence against women, had been organized in November 2019, organized by the minister of gender equality Marlene Schiappa ... violence against women continues to grow in France. A year and a half ago, the government gathered around experts to address the subject of domestic violence and try to stem this phenomenon which killed more than 140 women in 2019. A year later, close to the half of the measures announced during this Grenelle have been made effective, according to the government, which presented the results on the occasion of the international day for the elimination of violence against women. **STEPHANIE IS THE 43RD VICTIM OF FEMINICIDE IN 2021 KILLED VIOLENTLY STABBED BY BOYFRIEND----**

Stephanie Di Vincenzo, 22, is now the 43rd woman to have been killed by her partner since the start of the year. This is more than last year at the same time. Stephanie Di Vincenzo was stabbed to death in the night from Sunday to Monday. Several hundred people took part on Wednesday in a white march in Hayange (Moselle, eastern France) to pay tribute to Stéphanie Di Vincenzo, a 22-year-old young woman killed by her companion on the night from Sunday to Monday. The suspect, the attacker, is a 23-year-old Serbian national who has been indicted for spousal homicide and remanded in custody, Metz public prosecutor Christian Mercuri said. Stephanie had sheltered her in her escape and was placed under judicial supervision after her release from prison, before he killed her. The government has asked for an inspection mission to check if there have been any malfunctions. According to BFMTV, the prison administration had reported the suspect's violence to justice after an incident with his partner in the visiting room. The General Inspectorate of Administration and the General Inspectorate of Justice will have to determine the circumstances which led to the murder. Source: France Info, BFM TV France TV
