

PREFECT ANNOUNCES THE SHELTERING DEVICE OF THE MOST VULNERABLE PEOPLE IN PARIS

DURING THE WINTER MONTHS

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USPA NEWS - Throughout the year, the state, in Île-de-France, is in the process to ensure accommodation capacities for people in difficulty and hosts 67,000 people every night. This mobilisation is reinforced at the arrival of the winter.

THE WINTER TRUCE 2015-2016-----

In preparation for winter, from late September, Jean-Francois Carenco, prefect of the Île-de-France, prefect of Paris, had met all institutional partners, Parisians and Ile de France, for a general mobilisation order identify the sites that will increase the accommodation capacity.-----

From 1 November 2015, the State, in conjunction with the city of Paris and its many partners: the Ministry of Defence, the AP-HP, France Domaine, La Poste, SNCF, Adoma, EDF increases ... human and financial resources devoted to the care of homeless people. In Ile-de-France, the number of mobilised places for winter 2015-2016 is € 2 500 beds (excluding gyms) with 1190 places in Paris on 1 November 2015. More additional 700 beds perpetuated are planned in the extension of the winter campaign last year.

In 2014, 2200 places were mobilised in Île-the-France and 700 places were perpetrated between 2014 and 2015. In Paris, 1000 places were mobilised in Paris in 2014 and 300 people were perpetrated between 2014 and 2015.-----

The strengthening of capacities in Paris was made possible thanks to the mobilisation of the government departments and the city of Paris has made available to the State four buildings to house families and single persons.-----

In addition, a plan is in place with mobile aid teams Samu social (20h-5h) and a network of associations (Order of Malta, Emmaus, Aurora, Aux captives release, etc.) on the streets of the capital and the neighbouring woods.-----

Additional outreach patrols and teams of volunteers will enhance the device based on the number of reports and felt temperatures. Thus, the state boosts its device with the approach of winter, while continuing the plan to reduce the use of the hotel.

SPECIAL SITUATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE ARRIVAL OF MIGRANTS-----

In addition, the constant mobilisation of the State for the care of the most vulnerable population throughout the year continues: 67,000 people each day hosted by the State Île-de-France including: - 20 000 accommodation places outside hotel in Ile-de-France. - 32 000 beds to the hotel in Ile-de-France, - 12,000 people in Solibail.-----

The present context is particular as accommodation in Île-de-France is experiencing a recurrent situation of tension.

The device of the winter 2015-2016 campaign for the reception of the poor falls this year in a particular context which is characterised by welcoming migrants.-----

Thus in four months, there are 3664 housing solutions that have been proposed to migrants present in street camps, setting off after the 11 operations since June 2. In budgetary terms, the total cost of 11 management operations of migrants has costed 15 million euros. To this is added the 526 migrants arrived from Germany last September and supported by the services of the State in Île-de-France.-----

The regional prefect is proud of the work done by the State services in this period of migration crisis and recalled that this support is part of the Republican line asserted by the Government, "solidarity is a guarantee reception of refugees and asylum seekers, but this solidarity "is not to deteriorate the situation of those of our citizens who need help." "There is no competition between different public and our country is proud of its hospitality, its mobilisation and his humanity"[2].
